## ▶ **Accessing Brainfuse**

1. Visit your library's website and select the **eResources** tab, or visit [marigold.ab.ca/eResources](http://marigold.ab.ca/eResources).
2. Under **Brainfuse**, select **HelpNow** or **JobNow**.
3. Login with your **library card barcode number** and **PIN number** (if you do not know your **PIN number**, contact your local library).
4. In the top right corner, click on **My Account** and select **Login**.
5. Click **Sign Up** and enter the required information. Click on **Next**. You can now log into Brainfuse.

### **IMPORTANT**

HelpNow is available on Apple and Android. Users must create an account before logging in on the mobile app. JobNow is not available on the mobile app.

**Study** - take practice tests, create flashcards, and find college majors and more.

**Collaborate** - schedule study sessions with friends.

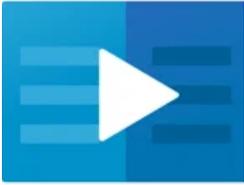
## ▶ **JobNow**

### Computer

1. Visit your library's website and select the **eResources** tab, or visit [marigold.ab.ca/eResources](http://marigold.ab.ca/eResources).
2. Click on **LinkedIn Learning** and select **Get Started**.
3. Log in with your **library card barcode number** and **PIN number** (if you do not know your **PIN number**, contact your local library).

### Mobile App

1. Download the LinkedIn Learning app from the Apple App Store or Google Play.
2. Open the app and select **Sign in**. Click **Sign in with your library card**.
3. Enter your Library ID: **marigoldlibrarysystem** and click **Continue**.
4. Log in with your **library card barcode number** and **PIN number** (if you do not know your **PIN number**, contact your local library).

## Finding Courses

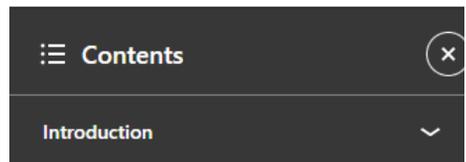
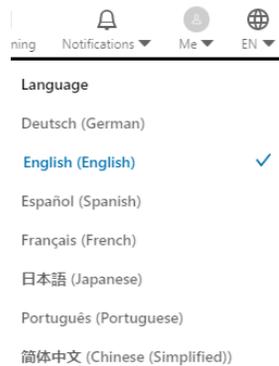
- ▶ Scroll through popular and recommended courses on the homepage.

## ▶ Accessing Pronunciator

### Computer

1. Visit your library's website and select the **eResources** tab, or visit [marigold.ab.ca/eResources](http://marigold.ab.ca/eResources).
2. Click on **Pronunciator**.
3. Log in with your **library card barcode number** and **PIN number** (if you do not know your **PIN number**, contact your local library).
4. If you are a first time user, select **Register** to create an account to save your progress.
5. **Select Instant Access** if you do not want to save your progress.

### Mobile App

1. Download the **Bluebird app** from the Apple App Store or Google Play.
2. Open the app. If you have used Pronunciator before, select **Log in**.
3. If you have not used Pronunciator before, click **Get Started**.
4. Enter your **email address** and create a **password**.
5. Check the box that says **I am an institutional user and have a PIN code**. Enter **MARI** and click **Sign Up**.

## ▶ Choose Your Course

Once you have created an account, you can start exploring the course options.

- ▶ Select what language you speak and choose a language that you want to learn.
- ▶ Choose the type of course you want to take.
- ▶ Once you have selected your language and the type of course, you can instantly start learning.

## ▶ Accessing Solaro

### Computer

1. Visit your library's website and select the **eResources tab**, or visit [marigold.ab.ca/eResources](http://marigold.ab.ca/eResources).
2. Click on **Solaro**.
3. Enter your **library card barcode number** and click **Request**. Solaro will generate a log in for you.
4. Once you receive your username and password, click on [www.solaro.com](http://www.solaro.com).
5. Enter your **username** and **password** and click **Log in**.

### Mobile App

1. Download the Solaro app from the Apple App Store or Google Play.
2. Open the app and log in with your **username or email address** and **password**.

**NOTE:** To receive your username and password from Solaro, **it is recommended that you first access Solaro on your computer.**

## ▶ Adding Courses

1. Click **Add Course**.
2. Select your **Region** (Alberta) and **Grade**. Click **Update**.
3. Select all the courses you would like to add.

## ▶ For Parents

Students can send parents an invitation to monitor their progress.

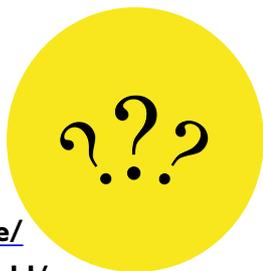
1. Click on the profile tab in the top right corner and select **My Account**.
